Certification Exam Protocol

For applicants applying for a Small Water System (SWS) certificate, the applicant must write and pass with a mark of 70% the SWS exam or both the Water Treatment 1 and Water Distribution 1 exams. This same rule applies for a Small Wastewater System (SWWS) certificate. The SWWS exam must be written, and passed, or both the Wastewater Treatment 1 and Wastewater Collection 1 exams.

The protocol remains the same for any applicant requesting Level 1, 2, 3 or 4 certificates in any area. Exams must be written for each level of certification up to the desired level. For example if an operator is applying for Water Distribution level 4 he must first write and pass all the certification exams for level 1 up to level 4.
