### Renewal of Expired Saskatchewan Certificates

For Operators applying for certification after allowing their certificates to lapse; lapsed time shall be counted from the date of expiry and not the date of issuance or renewal date.

- i. Application can be made for certification at previously held level(s) and area(s).
- ii. As per *The Waterworks and Sewage Works*, one (1) Continuing Education Unit (CEU) is required for each renewal period that has lapsed.
