## **Reciprocity Agreements**

Water Security Agency (WSA) authorizes the Board to:

- 1. Participate and enter into Reciprocity Agreements with all Canadian provinces and territories.
- 2. Review and/or accept reciprocity applications from Operators, who meet the certification standards of Saskatchewan, from Canadian provinces and territories that have reciprocity agreements in good standing
- 3. Review and/or accept applications from Operators, who meet the certification standards of Saskatchewan, from Canadian provinces and territories that do NOT have reciprocity agreements
- 4. Accept all certificates that are issued in the province of Alberta in all categories of Level One (1) through Level Four (4).

The Board will issue reciprocity to applicants if they are employed in a Saskatchewan classified facility and are in good standing in a province or territory that the province Saskatchewan has a Reciprocity Agreement with. Certification will be given for all certificates previously earned by the Operator regardless of the facility class or category of the current employer.
