Duties:

- Completes laboratory analysis and computer-controlled operations
- Samples and tests wastewater quality

- Maintains records such as detailed work performed, equipment installed, problems encountered, resources used, and repairs made.
- Assists with the development of Business Division procedures
- Assists associate staff members with Business Division records, bylaws, policies and procedures
