Reporting to the Public Works Manager, the successful candidate will be responsible for:

- Operating and maintaining the municipal water treatment and distribution system.
- Monitoring water quality and ensuring compliance with all provincial regulations.
- Performing routine sampling, testing, inspections, and record keeping.
- Assisting with the operation and maintenance of the wastewater system.
- Maintaining pumps, valves, equipment, and related infrastructure.
- Responding to water emergencies and participating in an on-call rotation.
- Assisting with other Public Works operations, including streets, parks, snow removal, and municipal infrastructure maintenance as required.

The ideal candidate will:

- Hold a valid Saskatchewan Water Treatment and/or Water Distribution Operator Certification (or equivalent recognized in Saskatchewan).
- Possess a valid Class 5 driver's licence (higher class licence is considered an asset).
- Have strong mechanical aptitude and troubleshooting skills.
- Be able to work safely in a physically demanding outdoor environment in all weather conditions.
- Demonstrate excellent communication, teamwork, and problem-solving abilities.
- Be self-motivated, dependable, and committed to providing exceptional public service.
